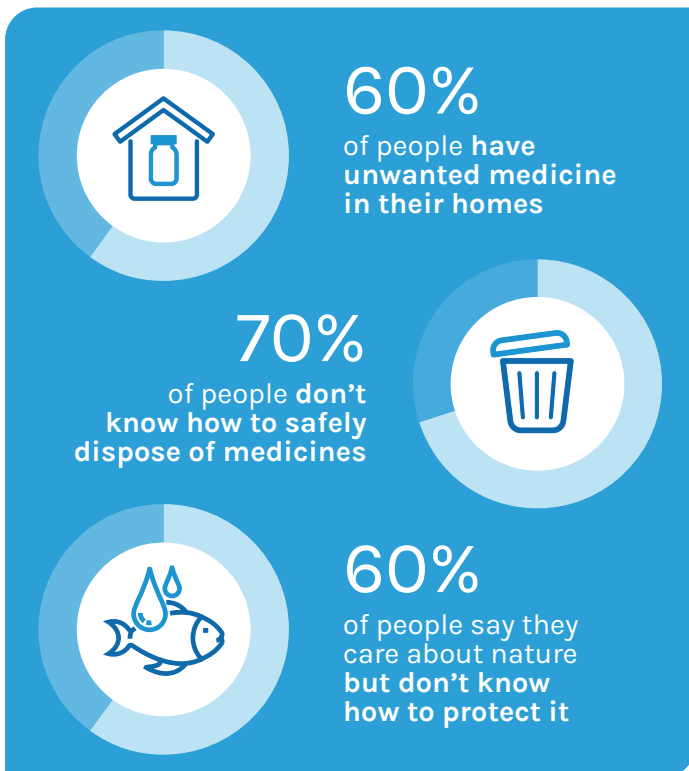




# Are your unwanted medicines harming the environment?

**READ**  
Read medicine labels and check expiry dates. Do you still need them?

**REMOVE**  
Remove all expired and unwanted medicines.

**RETURN**  
Return all unwanted medicines to your local pharmacy – who will help dispose of them safely.

**DID YOU KNOW?**  
Pet medicine is also collected at your pharmacy.

Your local pharmacy accepts all medicines including prescription, over-the-counter, herbal or complementary supplements, gels, liquids, or topical creams

To safely dispose of needles or sharps, please speak to your pharmacist.
